University of Latvia and **Association for Teacher Education in Europe (ATEE)** in cooperation with **Riga City Council** invites pedagogues, educators, students and any other person interested to take part in ATEE Spring Conference 2015, taking place in Riga 8-9th May 2015.

Theme of the conference is **“Teacher of the 21st century: Qualitative education for qualitative teaching”**. It is an opportunity for everyone to take part in a discussion about modern qualitative education, innovative ideas in pedagogy and the possibilities of implementing them. How do changes in society help in the pedagogical process in schools and universities? How should pedagogues and researchers organize their own work in order not to lose track of educational goals during the changes? What has changed in the period since the year 2000?

Publications, which will be submitted in English and will be prepared according to the standards, and which will be acknowledged by the reviewers as the best and the most corresponding to the theme of the conference will be submitted for **“Cambridge Scholars Publishing”**. A cooperation with the publisher has been established by publishing the best submissions from ATEE Spring Conference 2013, the book is available afterwards in various data bases - Dawsons, EBL, EBSCO, Ebrary, Gardners, Wheelers, MyiLibrary. The published version of the digest is also available in the British Library.
